Wankel engine The Wankel engine's rotor is similar in shape to a Reuleaux triangle, with the sides having less curvature. Exhaust gas temperatures can exceed 1,300 K (1,030 °C; 1,880 °F) under high load at engine speeds of 6000 rpm. To improve the exhaust gas behavior of The Wankel engine (, VAHN-kəl) is a type of internal combustion engine using an eccentric rotary design to convert pressure into rotating motion. The midpoint of the rotor moves in a circle around the output shaft, rotating the shaft via a cam. The rotor spins inside a figure-eight-like epitrochoidal housing around a fixed gear. The concept was proven by German engineer Felix Wankel, followed by a commercially feasible engine designed by German engineer Hanns-Dieter Paschke 67e61c1c8e

This thermal inefficiency has restricted the Wankel engine to limited use since its introduction in the 1960s. However, many disadvantages have mainly been overcome over the succeeding decades following the development and production of road-going vehicles. The advantages of compact design, smoothness, lower weight, and fewer parts over reciprocating internal combustion engines make Wankel engines suited for applications such as chainsaws, auxiliary... 67e61c1c8e The roots of biodiesel as a fuel source can be traced back to when J. Patrick and E. Duffy first conducted transesterification of vegetable oil in 1853, predating Rudolf Diesel's development of the diesel engine. Diesel's engine, initially designed for mineral oil, successfully ran on peanut oil at the 1900 Paris Exposition. This landmark event highlighted the potential of vegetable oils as an alternative fuel source. The interest in using vegetable oils as fuels resurfaced periodically, particularly during resource-constrained periods such as World War II. However, challenges such as high viscosity and resultant engine deposits were significant hurdles.
