Household smoke detectors, also known as smoke alarms, generally issue an audible or visual alarm from the detector itself or several detectors if there are multiple devices interconnected. Household smoke detectors range from individual battery-powered units to several interlinked units with battery backup. With interlinked units, if any unit detects smoke, alarms will trigger all of the units. This happens even if household power has gone out. A great variety of methods for detecting landmines have been studied. These include electromagnetic methods, one of which (ground penetrating radar) has been employed in tandem with metal detectors. Acoustic methods can sense the cavity created by mine casings. Sensors have been developed to detect vapor leaking from landmines. Demining Acoustic methods can sense the cavity created by mine casings. In military operations, the object is to rapidly clear a path through a minefield, and this is often done with devices such as mine plows and blast waves. Mechanical devices such as flails and excavators are sometimes used to clear mines. with metal detectors. Specially trained dogs are also used to narrow down the search and verify that an area is cleared. By contrast, the goal of humanitarian demining is to remove all of the landmines to a given depth and make the land safe for human use. CO is a colorless, tasteless, and odorless gas produced by incomplete combustion of carbon-containing materials. It is often referred to as the "silent killer" because it is virtually undetectable by humans. In a study by UL, "Sixty percent of Americans could not identify any potential signs of a CO leak in the home". Elevated levels of CO can be dangerous to humans depending on the amount present and length of exposure. Smaller concentrations can be harmful over longer periods while increasing concentrations require diminishing exposure times to be harmful. 3178acfa9e == Safe practices == 3178acfa9e A zinc-carbon battery is a dry cell that provides direct electric current from the electrochemical reaction between zinc (Zn) and manganese dioxide (MnO₂) in the presence of an ammonium chloride (NH₄Cl) electrolyte. It produces a voltage of about 1.5 volts between the zinc anode, which is typically constructed as a cylindrical container for the battery cell, and a carbon rod surrounded by a compound with a higher standard electrode potential (positive polarity), known as the cathode, that collects the current from the manganese dioxide electrode. The name "zinc-carbon" is slightly misleading as it implies that carbon is acting as the oxidizing agent rather than the manganese dioxide. 3178acfa9e

Smoke detector Sensitive detectors can be used to detect and deter smoking in banned areas. Detectors may use one or both sensing methods. Smoke can be detected either optically (photoelectric) or by physical process (ionization). Smoke detectors/alarms are usually housed in plastic enclosures, typically shaped like a disk about 125 millimetres (5 in) in diameter and

25 millimetres (1 in) thick, but shape and size vary.
