== History == Lewis Hamilton, who led the driver's championship, started from pole position, but he was overtaken at the first corner by Max Verstappen of Red Bull Racing, who led the rest of the race and claimed victory. Hamilton managed to recover from a minor crash to take second place for the Mercedes team, just ahead of the McLaren of Lando Norris. The race was temporarily stopped halfway through after a high-speed crash involving Valtteri Bottas and George Russell. The 63-lap race was won by Mercedes driver Lewis Hamilton, with his teammate Valtteri Bottas taking second place, and Renault driver Daniel Ricciardo taking the final podium place. With their drivers finishing first and second in the race, Mercedes secured the World Constructors' Championship, breaking the record for the most consecutive World Constructors' Championships, with seven.

== Background == The COVID-19 pandemic in 2020 resulted in the cancellation of a number of Grands Prix, so Formula One returned to the Imola circuit in 2020 to fill out the calendar. The race remained on the calendar afterward. In 2023, the event was cancelled due to flooding affecting the Emilia-Romagna region. The Grand Prix was discontinued after the 2025 race, being replaced by the Madring in 2026.

The race was won by Max Verstappen, ahead of his teammate Sergio Pérez and Lando Norris who finished third, his and McLaren's only podium of the season. It was Red Bull Racing's first 1–2 finish since the 2016 Malaysian Grand Prix, as well as Verstappen's second career grand slam, having started in pole position after winning the sprint race from first position on Saturday, and set the fastest lap while leading every lap of the race he won on Sunday. Championship leader Charles Leclerc finished sixth, while his teammate Carlos Sainz Jr. retired on lap 1 after a collision with Daniel Ricciardo at turn 1. This was the only race in the 2022 season where a driver outside one of the top three constructors achieved a podium. The event was set to be held across the weekend of 19–21 May. It would have been the sixth round of the 2023 Formula One World Championship.

Emilia Romagna Grand Prix The venue previously hosted the Italian Grand Prix in 1980, and the San Marino Grand Prix from 1981 to 2006. The event took the name "Emilia-Romagna" from the Italian region where the circuit is located. The result reduced Piastri's lead in the World Drivers' Championship to 13 points over teammate Norris, with Verstappen 22 points behind Piastri. While McLaren comfortably led the Constructors' Championship with 279 points, third-placed Red Bull decreased their deficit to 16 points over second-placed Mercedes. 8ec3e85a4b Oscar Piastri of McLaren took pole position for the event, which was won by Red Bull Racing's Max Verstappen after overtaking Piastri into Variante Tamburello on the first lap and maintaining the lead to the finish; the McLarens of Lando Norris and Piastri completed the podium. This was Red Bull Racing's 400th Grand Prix appearance, and Sauber's 600th, in Formula One. 8ec3e85a4b
