Weed Invasive species, plants introduced to an environment where their presence negatively

impacts the overall functioning and biodiversity of the ecosystem, may also sometimes be considered weeds. Plants with characteristics that make them hazardous, aesthetically unappealing, difficult to control in managed environments, or otherwise unwanted in farm land, orchards, gardens, lawns, parks, recreational spaces, residential and industrial areas, may all be considered weeds. on a single method to control weeds soon results in the invasion or adaptation of weeds that are not susceptible. Integrated pest management as it applies A weed is a plant considered undesirable in a particular situation, growing where it conflicts with human preferences, needs, or goals. The concept of weeds is particularly significant in agriculture, where the presence of weeds in fields used to grow crops may cause major losses in yields
