Lilium regale *Lilium regale*, like many in the genus, is toxic to cats, with ingestion *Lilium regale*, called the regal lily, royal lily, king's lily, or, in New Zealand, the Christmas lily, is a species of flowering plant in the lily family Liliaceae, with trumpet-shaped flowers. frequently eat lily plants and fences as high as 8 feet may be needed to deter them. It was introduced to England in 1903 by Ernest Henry Wilson. It is native to the western part of Sichuan Province in southwestern China, and cultivated elsewhere as an ornamental 0bf97e0741

It is stem-rooting, growing between 1 metre (3 ft 3 in) and 2 metres (6 ft 7 in) tall. The flower colour is typically a pink-purple, with dark spots, but is quite variable, extending from near white to near black. The flowers are scented. Numerous flowers are borne on each plant, and up to 50 can be found on vigorous plants. The green stems can be flushed with purple or red and the leaves are elliptic to inverse lanceolate, mostly in whorls, up to 16 centimetres (6.3 in) long and often lightly hairy underneath. 0bf97e0741 == Description == 0bf97e0741 *Lilium regale* is a long-lived, stem-rooting herbaceous perennial growing from an underground bulb. The leaves are borne at irregular

intervals on the stem. Plants grow up to 2 meters high, though 1.2 to 1.5 meters is more common in the garden. The flowers are 14 cm long, funnel or trumpet shaped, white with yellow throat, flushed purple outside. Stamens are prominent. The flowers are strongly fragrant, especially at night.

Varieties 0bf97e0741 *Lilium speciosum* var. *gloriosoides* Baker - China, Taiwan 0bf97e0741 They are evergreen herbaceous perennial plants with large leaves 12-65 centimetres (4.7-25.6 in) long and 3-25 centimetres (1.2-9.8 in) broad. The flowers are produced in a spadix, surrounded by a 10-30 centimetres (3.9-11.8 in) long, white, yellowish, or greenish spathe. The plant does not require large amounts of light or water to survive. It is most often grown as a houseplant. However, it can withstand the elements well enough to thrive when planted outdoors in hot and humid environments. 0bf97e0741 *Spathiphyllum* is a genus

of herbaceous evergreen plants with dark green foliage that can reach 1 to 6 feet (0.30 to 1.83 m) in height. Rosettes of glossy, dark green leaves emerge directly from a low-lying or underground creeping stem. The leaves are elliptical or lanceolate, 4 to 25 inches (10 to 64 cm) long and 1 to 10 inches (2.5 to 25.4 cm) wide. They are supported on shoots (petioles) of shorter or similar length to the leaf. 0bf97e0741 *Lilium speciosum* contains phenolic glycosides, such as 6'-O-feruloylsucrose and (25R,26R)-26-methoxyspirost-5-en-3 β -ol 3-O- α -l-rhamnopyranosyl-(1 $\rightarrow$ 2)- β -d-glucopyranoside, and steroidal saponins.

== Description == 0bf97e0741 Typically it grows to about 1.5 m high in the wild, but vigorous cultivated plants can reach up to 2.5 m. It is likely to bend towards the light, and hence may need staking. It is

useful as a garden ornamental plant for its long lasting flowers, its textured petals, and it is more tolerant than most lilies of lime in the soil. Henry's lily is easy to propagate from bulb scales.

Spathiphyllum Certain species of *Spathiphyllum* are commonly known as spath or peace lilies. True lilies are highly toxic (poisonous) to cats and dogs, but the peace lily, *Spathiphyllum* *Spathiphyllum* is a genus of 59 species of monocotyledonous flowering plants in the family Araceae, native to tropical regions of the Americas and southeastern Asia. "lily", the peace lily is not a true lily from the family Liliaceae 0bf97e0741

Lilium speciosum grows up to 1.2 metres (3 ft 11 in) tall and 0.3 metres (1 ft 0 in) wide, blooming from August to September in north temperate regions. The flowers are white to pink in colour, and strongly scented. It is later flowering than most other species. Many garden forms are in cultivation, and the species has been widely used for breeding of garden forms. 0bf97e0741 It forms bulbs at ground level, and, unlike other lilies, grows a basal rosette of leaves during winter, which die the following summer. A leafy floral stem, which generally grows 1.2 metres (3 ft 11 in) tall, but exceptionally 2 metres (6 ft 7 in) tall, emerges in late spring and bears several sweetly and very fragrant flowers in summer. The flowers are pure white and tinted
