

# 175 Centimetres In Feet

Two subspecies—*P. t. terminalis* and *P. t. recurva*—are recognised; both are found on well-drained acidic soils in sclerophyll forests, and *P. t. terminalis* is also found on granite outcrops. Although similar in appearance, they differ in leaf length and curvature. Tooth-billed bowerbird It is a stocky olive-brown bird with brown-streaked buffish white underparts, grey feet, a brown iris The tooth-billed bowerbird (*Scenopoeetes dentirostris*), also known as the stagemaker bowerbird or tooth-billed catbird, is a species of passerine bird in the bowerbird family Ptilonorhynchidae. == Taxonomy == 155a266cd9 == Description == 155a266cd9 Before flowering, a stem bears about 20 pinnate leaves up to 10 m (33 ft) long. Each leaf has about 150–180 leaflets up to 175 centimetres (5+1/2 ft) long. The inflorescence, 3–7.5 m (10–24+1/2 ft) tall and wide, consists of the continuation of the stem and 15–30 upwardly-curving (first-order) branches spirally arranged on it. Each first-order branch has 15–25 rigid, distichously arranged second-order branches; each second-order branch has 10–12 rigid, distichously arranged third-order branches. Flower pairs are spirally arranged on the third-order branches, each pair consisting of one male and one hermaphrodite flower. The fruit is drupe-like, about 5 cm (2 in) in diameter, covered in scales which turn from bright green to straw-coloured upon ripening. 155a266cd9

Bellatoripes Fossils of *Bellatoripes* are notable for preserving trackways of multiple individual tyrannosaurids all travelling in the same direction at similar speeds, suggesting the prints may have been made by a group, or pack, of tyrannosaurids moving together. 74 ft) and strides of almost 350 centimetres (11. over 50 centimetres (20 in) in length, and trackways record pace lengths of nearly 175 centimetres (5. Such inferences of behaviour cannot be made with fossil bones alone, so the record of *Bellatoripes* tracks together is important for understanding how large predatory theropods such as tyrannosaurids may have lived. *Persoonia terminalis* was first reported by Lawrie Johnson of the Royal Botanic... 155a266cd9 == Description == 155a266cd9 The tooth-billed bowerbird was formally described in 1876 by the Australian zoologist Edward Pierson Ramsay. He introduced a new genus *Scenopoeus* and coined the binomial name *Scenopoeus dentirostris*. Unfortunately the name *Scenopoeus* had earlier been used by Louis Agassiz for a genus of insects and in 1891 the American ornithologist Elliott Coues introduced a replacement name, *Scenopoeetes*. The genus name *Scenopoeetes* combines the Ancient Greek σκηνή/*skēnē* meaning "stage" or "tent" with ποιητής/*poiētēs* meaning "maker". The specific epithet *dentirostris* is derived from Latin *dens*, *dentis* meaning "tooth" and "-rostris" meaning "-billed". The tooth-billed bowerbird is monotypic: no subspecies are recognised. 155a266cd9 Leedsichthys fossils have been difficult to interpret because the skeletons were not completely made of bone. Large parts consisted of cartilage that did not fossilize. On several occasions the enigmatic large partial remains have been mistaken for stegosaurian dinosaur bones. As the vertebrae are among the parts that have not been preserved, it is hard to determine the total body length. Estimates have varied significantly. At the beginning of the twentieth century, a length of 9 m (30... 155a266cd9 Alexander Milov is a Ukrainian sculptor, blacksmith, and designer. Milov has said that he first came up with the idea for Love in 2007. He constructed the sculpture with dimensions of 75 by 45 by 175 centimetres (30 in × 18 in × 69 in). It was made of tape and wire and was put on display at the Kyiv Museum of Contemporary Art. the finds by the British collector Alfred Nicholson Leeds, after whom the genus was named "Leeds' fish" in 1889. The type species is Leedsichthys problematicus. Leedsichthys fossils have been found in England, France, Germany and Chile. In 1999, based on the Chilean discoveries, a second species was named Leedsichthys notocetes, but this was later shown to be indistinguishable from L. problematicus. 155a266cd9 True sago palm is a suckering (multiple-stemmed) palm, each stem only flowering once (hapaxanthic) with a large upright terminal inflorescence.
