The washstand was a bathroom sink made in the United States

English tradition. Sometimes the table had a hole where the
large bowl rested, which led to the making of dry sinks. From
about 1820 to 1900, the dry sink evolved by the addition of a
wooden cabinet with a trough built on the top, lined with zinc

== Drawing set == In British English, "commode" is the standard term for a commode chair, often on wheels, enclosing a chamber pot—as used in hospitals and assisted living homes. In the United States, a "commode" is now a colloquial synonym for a flush toilet. In his *Pneumatics*, (chapter 31) Philo of Byzantium, a Greek engineer and writer on mechanics, describes an escapement mechanism, the earliest known, as part of a washstand. A counterweighted spoon, supplied by a water tank, tips over in a basin when full releasing a pumice in the process. Once the spoon has emptied, it is pulled up again by the counterweight, closing the door on the pumice by the tightening string.

Remarkably, Philon's comment that "its construction is similar to that of clocks" indicates that such escapement...
