The building was formerly the headquarters for WarnerMedia until the company merged with Discovery, Inc. in 2022 to form Warner Bros. Discovery; WBD remains a tenant of the building. Robert H. Burns, founder of Regent International Hotels, approached Harunori Takahashi, owner of EIE International Corporation company to build a luxurious hotel on the property. f9c3d6278a Five years later, in June 2007, Somerset Partners bought 450 Park Avenue for \$509 million, or \$1,566 per square foot (\$16,860/m²). This made it the highest price per square foot paid for an office building at the time in the United States. To pay for the building, Somerset Partners signed a \$175 million loan. In mid-2008, Somerset Partners also moved its head office to the building. f9c3d6278a The hotel building contains a facade of brick, limestone, and architectural terracotta. It contains light courts facing north and west, as well as setbacks to comply with the 1916 Zoning Resolution. The limestone base is two to three stories high and contains storefronts, a main entrance on 48th Street, and an archway on Lexington Avenue. The upper stories are generally clad with plain brick and contain random projecting groups of bricks; there is a narrow tower at the top of the building. The basement contains a restaurant space that formerly housed event venues, including the Hawaiian Room. When the hotel opened, it had 814 guestrooms, though this has been reduced over the years. f9c3d6278a Midtown Manhattan is the largest central business district in the world and ranks among the world's most expensive locations for real estate; Fifth Avenue in Midtown Manhattan has commanded the world's highest retail rents and had been ranked as the most expensive shopping street in the world before falling to second in 2024. Charlie Palmer (chef) steakhouse, Charlie Palmer Steak in The Four Seasons. In March 2021, Palmer Charlie Palmer (born 1959) is an American chef, hospitality entrepreneur, hotelier, and author. He is best known for Aureole, his flagship restaurant in New York City and Las Vegas, which has earned 15 Michelin stars and two James Beard awards. Considered a “pioneer of progressive American cooking,” Palmer has received more than 20 Michelin stars and owns and manages more than 15 restaurants and three hotels via Charlie Palmer Collective and Appellation Hotels. New York City had an extensive ferry network until the 1960s, when almost all ferry services were discontinued, but saw a revival in the 1980s and 1990s. During 2013 the city government officially proposed its own ferry service, which was announced two years later under the tentative name of Citywide Ferry Service. The first of two phases launched in 2017 with service along the East River and to the Rockaways, Bay Ridge, and Astoria. A second phase launched to the Lower East Side and Soundview in 2018. A ferry to St. George, Staten Island, and a stop in Throggs Neck/Ferry Point Park launched in 2021, while a proposed route to Coney Island has been postponed indefinitely as of 2022. f9c3d6278a
