Motion compensation is one of the two key video compression techniques used in video coding standards, along with the discrete cosine transform (DCT). Most video coding standards, such as the H.26x and MPEG formats, typically use motion-compensated DCT hybrid coding, known as block motion compensation (BMC) or motion-compensated DCT (MC DCT).
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Motion compensation technique used to predict a frame in a video given the previous and/or future frames by accounting for motion of the camera or objects in the video. Motion compensation describes a picture in terms of the transformation of a reference picture to the current picture. When images can be accurately synthesized from previously transmitted/stored images, the compression efficiency can be improved. They comprise a series of individual frames, but when these images are shown rapidly in succession, the illusion of motion is seen by the viewer. Flickering between frames is not noticeable due to an effect traditionally known as persistence of vision, and now more specifically known as flicker fusion, whereby the visual system processes a sufficiently fast succession of pictures and interruptions into a steady image of averaged brightness.
