Emin ardently defended My Bed against critics who, treating it as a farce, claimed that anyone could exhibit an unmade bed. To these claims, she retorted, "Well, they didn't, did they? No one had ever done that before." f914249f50 Parkins, the protagonist, is a young "Professor of Ontography" at the University of Cambridge, who when the story opens is about to embark on a golfing holiday at the town of Burnstow on the east coast of England.
