Invitations to prospective pen pals and letters to actual or imagined love interests have also been sent as messages in bottles.

PET bottle recycling Compared to glass bottles, the PET bottle is lightweight and has a lower carbon footprint in production and transportation. Recycling further reduces emissions. However, it accounts for 12% in global solid waste. Its global market size was estimated to be worth US\$37. Polyethylene terephthalate is used in several applications such as; textile fibres, bottles, rigid/flexible packaging, and electronics. The recycled material can be put back into bottles, fibres, film, thermoformed packaging and strapping. In 2023, the US collected 1,962 million pounds of bottles for recycling. Plastic bottles were first used commercially in 1947, but remained impractical until the 1970s, when the PET bottle was introduced.

They quickly became popular with manufacturers and customers because they are lighter, cheaper and easier to transport than glass bottles and less susceptible to corrosion than metal containers. However, their greatest advantage over glass bottles is their superior resistance to breakage, in both production and transportation. In 1966 the Boiling Spring Holding Corporation purchased the spring and its surrounding woodlands from the B&O Railroad and incorporated as Deer Park Spring Water, Inc., named for the nearby town of Deer Park, Maryland.
