In most cases, a door's interior matches its exterior side. But in other cases (e.g., a vehicle door) the two sides are radically different. 1d6ac60276 No. 21 was built in 1919 and entered service on May 30 of that year. Car 21 was one of four cars purchased new by the Fort Collins Municipal Railway (FCMR) at that time (numbered 20–23), built by the American Car Company, of St. Louis... 1d6ac60276 A deadlock, if it is cylinder operated, may be either single cylinder or double cylinder. A single cylinder deadlock will accept a key on one side of the lock, but is operated by a twist knob on the other side. Double cylinder locks will accept a key on both sides and therefore do not require (and often do not have) any twist knob. This prevents unwanted unlocking of the door by forced access to the interior twist knob (via a nearby window, for example). Double cylinder locks are sometimes banned from areas because they can be difficult to open from... 1d6ac60276

A related concept is the pet gate, which is easy for

humans to open but acts as a secure pet barrier. They offer a degree of protection against wind, rain, and larger-bodied intruders entering the dwelling. Similar hatches can let dogs through fences at stiles. Originally simple holes, the modern form is a hinged and often spring-loaded panel or flexible flap, and some are electronically controlled

Window blind There are also several types of window coverings, called shades, that use a single piece of soft material instead of slats. popular styles of blinds: Panel Pleated Roller Roman Venetian Vertical Wooden Window blinds can be drawn manually using a cord, or automated through motorization A window blind is a type of window covering (also known as blinds). Vertical blinds run along a track system which can tilt open and closed and move side-to-side. A typical window blind is made up of several long horizontal or vertical slats of various types of hard material, including wood, plastic or metal which are held together by cords that run through the blind slats. Window blinds can be manoeuvred with either a manual or remote control by rotating them from an open position, with slats spaced out, to a closed position where slats overlap and block out most of the light. Revolving doors were designed to relieve the immense pressure caused by air rushing through high-rise buildings (referred to as stack effect pressure) while at the same time allowing large numbers of people to pass in and out. They are also energy efficient; they act as an airlock to prevent drafts, decreasing the loss of heating or cooling for the building as compared to a standard door. 1d6ac60276

Revolving door To use a revolving door, a person enters the enclosure between two of the doors and then moves continuously to the desired exit while keeping pace with the doors. Garage doors are made of wood, metal, or fiberglass, and may be insulated to reduce heat loss. Less commonly, some garage doors slide or swing horizontally or vertically. 1d6ac60276 A pet door is found to be convenient by many owners of companion animals, especially dogs and cats, because it lets the pets come and go as they please, reducing the need for pet-owners to let or take the pet outside manually, and curtailing unwanted behaviour such as loud vocalisation to be let outside, scratching on doors or walls, and (especially in the case of dogs) excreting in the house. Deadbolt It is distinct from a A deadbolt or deadlock is a type of lock morticed into a wooden door where a bolt is thrown into the door frame, using a key from either side, to secure the door. of lock morticed into a wooden door where a bolt is thrown into the door frame, using a key from either side, to secure the door. It is distinct from a spring bolt lock because a deadbolt can only be opened by a key or handle. The more common spring bolt lock uses a spring to hold the bolt in place, allowing retraction by applying force to the bolt itself. A deadbolt is often used to complement a spring-bolt lock on an entry door to a building. A deadbolt can therefore make a door more resistant to entry without the correct key, as well as make the door more resistant to forced entry 1d6ac60276

Many doors incorporate locking mechanisms to ensure that only some people can open them (such as with a key).
