Some movements were conscious attempts to revisit rock's history, including the garage rock and post-punk Rock music is a genre of popular music that originated in the United States as "rock and roll" in the late 1940s and early 1950s, developing into a range of styles from the late 50s to mid-1960s, primarily in the United States and United Kingdom. It has its roots beginning as classic rock and roll, a style that drew from the African-American musical genres of blues and rhythm and blues, as well as from country music. Rock also drew strongly from genres such as electric blues and folk, and incorporated influences from jazz and other styles ¶

Important influences on the depiction of the Ripper include Marie Belloc Lowndes' 1913 novel *The Lodger*, which has been adapted for the stage and film, and Stephen Knight's 1976 work *Jack the Ripper: The Final Solution*, which expanded on a conspiracy theory involving freemasons and royalty. The literature of the late Victorian era, including Arthur Conan Doyle's first Sherlock Holmes stories and Robert Louis Stevenson's *Strange Case of Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde*, has provided inspiration for story-makers who have fused these fictional worlds with the Ripper. ¶
