**Acorn** In 2024, the world production of Brazil nuts was 79,736 tonnes, with Brazil and Bolivia combined accounting for 87% of the total. Botanically, a nut is a fruit with a woody pericarp developing from a syncarpous gynoecium. True nuts include, for example, chestnut, hazelnut, and filbert. Culinarily, the term 'nut' is used much more widely, and includes examples of drupes (such as pecans and almonds) or seeds (such as pine nuts and peanuts).

Sturtevant adds that Bernard Romans noted that "This milk they are very fond of and eat it with sweet potatoes in it." 717ba2bc5b Most seeds come from fruits that naturally free themselves from the shell, but this is not the case in nuts such as hazelnuts, chestnuts, and acorns, which have hard shell walls and originate from a compound ovary. The general and original use of the term is less restrictive, and many nuts (in the culinary sense), such as almonds, pistachios, and Brazil nuts, are not 'nuts' in a botanical sense. Common use of the term 'nut' often refers to any hard-walled, edible kernel. Nuts are an energy-dense and nutrient-rich food source. 717ba2bc5b Areca nut production in India is the largest in the world, as per the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) statistics for 2017, accounting for 54.07% of its world output, and is exported to many countries. Within India, as of 2013-14, Karnataka produces 62.69% of the crop followed by Kerala and Assam; all three states together account for 88.59% of its production. In the other states of Meghalaya, Tamil Nadu, and West Bengal, where it is also consumed, the crop is grown in a very small area. In Karnataka, in the Uttara Kannada District and Shivamogga District the crop is grown extensively 717ba2bc5b

Kanuchi Hickory was the nut of choice (probably the species *Carya ovata*, known for its natural sweetness), since it is a nut tree endemic to North America, and is known to grow plentifully in those forested areas settled by the Cherokee. nutmeat is high in both fat and protein, containing 3% water, 18% carbohydrates, 13% protein, and 64%

fats. The nut was generally rendered into oil or Kanuchi (Cherokee: ᎊᎩᎩ, ka-nv-tsi; or ᎊᎩᎩ, ga-na-tsi) is a hickory nut soup eaten originally by the Cherokee people and which consists primarily of ground hickory nuts boiled in water 717ba2bc5b
