The leaf fall season causes the Slippery rail, or low railhead adhesion, is a condition of railways (railroads) where contamination of the railhead reduces the traction between the wheel and the rail. This can lead to wheelslip when the train is taking power, and wheelslide when the train is braking. Railhead contamination caused by weather conditions can occur at any time of year. The condition results in significant reduction in friction between train wheels and rails, and in extreme cases can render the track temporarily unusable. One common cause of contamination is fallen leaves that adhere to the railhead (top surface) of railway tracks.
