The tiny home movement The tiny-house movement (also known as the small house movement) is an architectural and social movement promoting the reduction and simplification of living spaces. What further complicates the definition is that tiny homes may or may not be mobile, and lack clearly defined features. However, the lack of clearly defined features and legality in many cases can cause issues for ownership, including being more expensive for the amount of area, vulnerability to natural disaster, lack of storage, difficulty hosting, smaller or lacking traditional home appliances, and legal and or zoning issues. Suntop Homes One converted it from a four bedroom house (in plan) to two bedrooms, and added The Suntop Homes, also known under the early name of The Ardmore Experiment, were quadruple residences located in Ardmore, Pennsylvania, and based largely upon the 1935 conceptual Broadacre City model of the minimum houses. the small bedrooms. Some owners converted the carports to living space. The design was commissioned by Otto Tod Mallery of the Tod Company in 1938 in an attempt to set a new standard for the entry-level housing market in the United States and to increase single-family dwelling density in the suburbs. In cooperation with Frank Lloyd Wright, the Tod Company secured a patent for the unique design, intending to sell development rights for Suntops across the country

The first (and only) of the four buildings planned for Ardmore was built in 1939, with the involvement of Wright's master builder Harold Turner, after initial construction estimates far surpassed the project budget set by the Tod Company. There were several reasons that construction of the other three planned units did not move forward, including the escalation of the World War, high construction costs and later, protests by local residents against multi-family housing in the neighborhood.

While 1954 is noted as the date of the Thaxton House design, as documented by author Paul V. Turner in his book "Frank Lloyd Wright and San Francisco", the floor plan and basic form of this house was created by Wright four years earlier in 1950, for different clients and a different site (the Bush House, for Stanford professor Robert N. Bush and his wife, sited on the Stanford University campus in Palo Alto, CA). According to Turner, the design was "resurrected and executed, with few changes for the Thaxton House". The earlier Bush House floor plan shown in Turner's book indeed looks almost identical to the published Thaxton House floorplan. While not common, Frank Lloyd Wright -- and the Wright Fellowship after his death -- did on several occasions take the opportunity to recycle an unbuilt design for an earlier location and... 1ea53d9a26 There is some variation in defining a tiny home, but there are examples and they are usually based on floorspace. bedroom models by Lustron Corporation and Chicago industrialist and inventor Carl Strandlund. Lustron production ceased in 1950 due to the company's inability to pay back the startup loans it had received from the Reconstruction Finance Corporation. Several have been added to the National Register of Historic Places. However, its Lustron houses are prefabricated enameled steel houses developed in the post-World War II era United States in response to the shortage of homes for returning G. Prefabricated housing had existed before the Lustron home came on the market. Over 2,000 homes were constructed during the Lustron's brief production period, and many remain in use today. Considered low-maintenance and extremely durable, they were expected to attract modern families who might not have the time for, or interest in, repairing and painting conventional wood and plaster houses.

The original concept of a newly built starter home outside of the city has changed due to both the end of low-cost land development and the changing preferences of successive generations in the United States. Since the end of the 20th century, more new homeowners are seeking different kinds of housing such as a condominium or older existing homes.
