1956 Indianapolis 500 Another change was made to the track that would have an immediate effect on the racing. The 1956 race was the first to be governed by the United States Automobile Club. The AAA withdrew from auto racing the previous August after a succession of incidents, including the Le Mans disaster and the fatal crash of Bill Vukovich during the 1955 race. It was Sneva's third runner-up finish in four years, matching Bill Holland's achievement exactly thirty years earlier in 1947, 1948 and 1950. The starting... b5910b615f During qualifying, defending IRL champion Greg Ray took the pole position. However, on race day, reigning CART champion Juan Pablo Montoya dominated the race. Montoya led 167 laps, and cruised to victory, becoming the first rookie winner since Graham Hill in 1966. It was the first of two Indy victories for Montoya (2000, 2015). Buddy Lazier, the 1996 winner, and eventual season champion... b5910b615f Qualifying was held on Friday, 20 March, and was split into two sessions. Session one lasted for 34 minutes and 15 seconds and saw the top ten drivers qualifying for the Top Ten Shootout, with positions 11–30 being set by times in the session. In this first session, reigning series champion Jamie Whincup set the pace, setting a new qualifying lap record of 1:21.2773. Although he was some half a second slower in the Shootout, Whincup was still quick enough to lead a Triple Eight Race Engineering 1–2 with Craig Lowndes 0.2545 seconds behind. Mark Winterbottom and Lee Holdsworth had both gone faster than Lowndes, but both drivers lost their respective times due to excessive kerbing use during their hot laps. 1978 Indianapolis 500 dominated the second half, and held a large lead late in the race. Danny Ongais dominated the early stages of the race but eventually dropped out with a blown engine. Unser held off the challenge, and became a three-time winner of the 500. However, Unser bent the front wing of his Lola during a pit stop on lap 180, causing his handling to go away over the final twenty laps.
