Sod is used to establish lawns or other greenways in spaces like golf courses or sports stadiums. Typically, after construction or other landscape disruption, builders, owners, and landscape specialists place sod to establish a grass cover. Description Sod is grown on specialized farms; the grass is grown for 12 to 18 months before the sod is cut from the top layer of the soil and prepared for transportation. Sod is often cut in either squares or rolls, making it easier to transport and distribute. Different species of grass are grown in different geographic regions because of the differing climatic conditions. More recently, some producers have developed turf mixes that include wildflowers and other native plants. Tall fescue is a long-lived tuft-forming perennial with erect to spreading hollow flowering stems up to about 165 cm (5 ft 5 in) tall (exceptionally up to 200 cm) which are hairless (glabrous), including the leaf sheaths, but with a short (1.5 mm) ligule and slightly hairy (ciliate) pointed auricles that can wrap slightly around the stem. The leaf blade is flat, up to about 10 mm wide, and also glabrous, but rough on both sides and the margins. The tillers (non-flowering stems) are typically shorter but otherwise similar to the culms. Poa pratensis In its native range, *Poa pratensis* forms a valuable pasture plant, characteristic of well-drained, fertile soil. It is a very popular lawn grass in North America with the species being spread over all of the cool, humid parts of the United States. It is also used for making lawns in

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parks and gardens and has established itself as a common invasive weed across cool moist temperate climates like the Pacific Northwest and the Northeastern United States. There is disagreement about its native status in North America, with some sources considering it native and others stating the Spanish Empire brought the seeds of Kentucky bluegrass to the New World in mixtures with other grasses.
