Recessed light is installed into a hollow opening in a ceiling. Most recessed fixtures are cylindrical and fit into a circular hole in the ceiling. U. S. Patent No. 1,470,728 for modern dropped ceilings was applied for by E. E. Hall on May 28, 1919, and granted on October 16, 1923. Initially modern dropped ceilings were built using interlocking tiles and the only way to provide access for repair or inspection of the area above the tiles was by starting at the edge of the ceiling, or at a designated "key tile", and then removing contiguous tiles one at a time until the desired place of access was reached. Canless recessed lights, also known as "wafer lights" are thin one-piece assemblies with a built-in LED light source. In comparison, kitchen, living room and bathroom ceilings would normally be finished in smoother skip-trowel or orange peel texture for their higher durability and ease of cleaning. Popcorn ceilings, in pre-1970s and early formulations, often contained white asbestos fibers. When asbestos was banned in ceiling treatments by the Clean Air Act in the United States in 1963, popcorn ceilings fell out of favor in much of the country. However, in order to minimize economic hardship to suppliers and installers, existing inventories of asbestos-bearing texturing materials were exempt from the ban, so it is possible to find asbestos in popcorn ceilings that were applied through the... 390366cf1a

Ceiling fan Fans do not reduce air temperature or relative humidity, unlike air-conditioning equipment, but create a cooling effect by helping to evaporate sweat and increase heat exchange via convection. Fans use significantly less power than air conditioning as cooling air is thermodynamically expensive. Many ceiling fan units also double as light fixtures, eliminating the need for separate overhead lights in a room. Fans add a small amount of heat to the room mainly due to waste heat from the motor, and partially due to friction. In the winter, fans move warmer air, which naturally rises, back down to occupants. There are three parts to a traditional recessed lighting fixture: housing, trim and bulb. The trim is the visible portion of the light. It is the insert that is seen when looking up into the fixture, and also includes the thin lining around the edge of the light. The housing is the fixture itself that is installed inside the ceiling and contains the lamp holder. There are many different types of bulbs that can be inserted into recessed lighting fixtures, with the amount of heat generated by the bulb being an important consideration. 390366cf1a

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
