It is generally considered to have been the first recorded speculative bubble or asset bubble in history. The major acceleration started in 1634 and then dramatically collapsed in February 1637. set in, the demand for tulips collapsed, and prices plummeted—the speculative bubble burst. The term tulip mania is now often used metaphorically to refer to any large economic bubble when asset prices deviate from intrinsic values. Some were left holding contracts to purchase tulips at prices Tulip mania (Dutch: tulpenmanie) was a period during the Dutch Golden Age when contract prices for some bulbs of the recently introduced and fashionable tulip reached extraordinarily high levels.
