Cat communication includes meowing, purring, trilling, hissing, growling, grunting, body language, and scent marking. It can hear sounds too faint or too high in frequency for human ears, such as those made by small mammals. It secretes and perceives pheromones. Feral cat active after dusk. Feral cats may breed over dozens of generations and become a mesopredator or even a local apex predator in urban, savannah and bushland environments, especially on islands where native animals did not evolve alongside natural predators. Some feral cats may become more comfortable with people who regularly feed them, but even with long-term attempts at socialization, they usually remain aloof and are most active after dusk. Cats are considered by the CSIRO to be the most damaging invasive pest by cost and fourth most damaging overall to the environment. The Invasive Species Council has estimated that each year domestic and feral cats in Australia kill nearly 1.1 billion mammals, 399 million birds, 609 million reptiles, 93 million frogs, and nearly 1.1 billion invertebrates. Cats are found to have significantly contributed to the extinction of at least 22 endemic Australian mammals since the arrival of Europeans. c17c33faa1 Some animal rights groups advocate trap-neuter-return programs to prevent the feral cats from continuing to breed. Cat It is a social species, but a solitary hunter and a crepuscular predator. It is a member of Felidae, the family of mammals in the order Carnivora also colloquially referred to as cats. contributes to the decline of native species. It is an obligate carnivore, requiring a predominantly meat-based diet. They are unfamiliar with and wary The cat (*Felis catus*), also called domestic cat and house cat, is a small domesticated carnivorous mammal. Its retractable claws are adapted to killing small prey species such as mice and rats. It has a strong, flexible body, quick reflexes, and sharp teeth, and its night vision and sense of smell are well developed. Feral cats are domestic cats that were born in or have reverted to a wild state c17c33faa1

Cats in Australia are estimated to be up to 6 million feral cats found in almost every remote area across the country. Cats are considered by the CSIRO to be the most damaging Cats (*Felis catus*), initially introduced into Australia with the First Fleet in 1788, now number more than 11 million distributed across more than 90% of the continent including every major island c17c33faa1

Recognized as both invasive species and predators, cats have been shown to cause significant ecological harm across various ecosystems. Some people view this as a desirable trait, such as in the case of barn cats and other cats kept for the intended purpose of pest control in rural settings; but scientific evidence does not support the popular use of cats to control urban rat populations, and ecologists oppose their use for this purpose because of the disproportionate harm they do to native wildlife c17c33faa1

Cats are disease carriers and can spread diseases to animals in their community and marine life.
