== Background ==

Pathetic fallacy It is a kind of personification that occurs in poetic descriptions, when, for example, clouds seem sullen, when leaves dance, or when rocks seem indifferent. (1855) by Alfred, Lord Tennyson, demonstrates what John Ruskin, in *Modern Painters*, said was an "exquisite" instance of the use of the pathetic fallacy: The phrase pathetic fallacy is a literary term for the attribution of human emotion and conduct to things found in nature that are not human. The English cultural critic John Ruskin coined the term in the third volume of his work *Modern Painters* (1856)

On 29 May 2018, All Saints announced the release of their fifth studio album – and second after their reunion – titled *Testament*. The Underworld had attendants... b300b9ee5d == Biography == b300b9ee5d Ruskin coined the term pathetic fallacy to criticize the sentimentality that was common to the poetry of the late 18th century, especially among poets like Burns, Blake, Wordsworth, Shelley, and Keats. Wordsworth supported this use of personification based on emotion by claiming that "objects ... derive their influence not from properties inherent in them ... but from such as are bestowed upon them by the minds of those who are conversant with or affected by these objects." However Tennyson, in his own poetry, began to refine and diminish such expressions, and introduced an emphasis on what might be called a more scientific comparison of objects in terms of sense perception. The old order was beginning to be replaced by the new just as Ruskin addressed... b300b9ee5d French Madeleines are very small sponge cakes with a distinctive shell-like shape acquired from being baked in pans with shell-shaped depressions. b300b9ee5d == Invention == b300b9ee5d Li Zhi was born in Jinjiang, Fujian province (in modern Quanzhou). His ancestor by seven generations was Lin Nu, the son of Li Lü, a maritime merchant. Lin Nu visited Hormuz in Persia in 1376, converted to Islam upon marriage to a Semu girl ("回回") (who was most likely either Persian or Arab), and brought her back to Quanzhou. This was recorded in the Lin and Li genealogy回回回回回回. However, the new faith did not take root in his lineage and the family stopped practising Islam during the time of his grandfather. His father made a living by teaching, and Li Zhi was therefore educated from an early age. b300b9ee5d
